Ordering food at a restaurant in **Ukrainian**

ббжа — food — is an important part of any culture. Ukrainian food is very diverse, and you can enjoy it for cheap in fast-food restaurants.

In this lesson, I want you to try to hear the conversation between me and the cashier at the food court as realistic as it is — through the sounds of people eating.

Do not forget to check the extended list of main Ukrainian dishes on the last page.





- Дайте, будь ласка, борщ.
- 3 смета́ною?
- Так, з смета́ною.
- I картопля́не пюре́, i котлету по-київськи, будь ласка. ... Дякую.
- Оди́н борщ, одне́ пюре́, One borscht, one mashed
- одна котлета і компот.
- Так.
- Разом сорок шість п'ятдесят.
- Мо́жна заплати́ти ка́рткою?
- Так, звичайно.
- Дя́кую!
- Смачного!

- Please give me a borscht.
- With sour cream?
- Yes, with sour cream.
- Also, mashed potatoes and a chicken Kyiv please. ... Thank you.
- potato, one meat chop, and a kompot (juice).
- Together 46.50.
- Can I pay by card?
- Yes. of course.
- Thank you!
- Enjoy your meal!

Дайте, будь ласка, борщ

Last time we learned some ways to order. Here we have one more:

Дайте, будь ласка...

Please give me...

Of course, you can use it not only while ordering things, but also when you want a person to give you something. However, be aware that it is a formal way. The informal "please give me" is:

Дай, будь ласка...

Therefore, here are four ways to order food or a drink in Ukrainian:

- Можна, будь ласка, борщ? Can I have a borscht?
- Картопляне пюре, будь ласка. Mashed potatoes, please.
- Я буду компот, будь ласка. I will have a kompot (a traditional Ukrainian juicy beverage).
- Дайте, будь ласка, котлету. Give me a meatball (or a meat chop), please.



For all these expressions, we need the accusative case of an object that is different only for feminine nouns:

- Дайте, будь ласка, котлету.
- Можна, будь ласка, каву?
- Я бу́ду ри́бу.

3 сметаною?

Смета́на — sour cream — is an important part of the Ukrainian food culture. We usually eat borscht with смета́на. So, if you want sour cream in your meal, say:

з сметаною

If you do not want it, say:

без сметани

Один борщ і одне пюре

In Ukrainian, the numeral **оди́н** is used in all genders, even in plural. So, depending on the gender of a noun, choose your **оди́н**:

оди́н	борщ, суп	masculine
одна́	котле́та, ри́ба	feminine
одне́	пюре́	neuter
одні́	о́вочі	plural

Можна заплатити карткою?

If you want to pay by card in Ukraine, first ask:

Можна заплатити карткою?

It means "Can I pay by card?" or "Is it possible to pay by card?". Again, the word мо́жна is very versatile.

Смачного!

This is a very nice phrase to say to any person who is eating near you:

Смачного!

Literally, it means: "Have a tasty one!"
