

How to install Ukrainian Lessons Anki flashcards

Thank you for purchasing Ukrainian Lessons Podcast Premium Membership!

Your materials include **digital flashcards** that can be used in the app called Anki. You can start using Anki flashcards by following these 3 simple steps.

Step 1 — Download and install Anki

You can [download and install Anki from here](#). I recommend you install Anki on your laptop / computer first, then you can synchronize it with the app on your phone.


Anki is free for Windows, Mac, Linux and Android (the app for Android is called **AnkiDroid**). Anki, however, is not free for iPhones / iPads.

Step#2 — Import .apkg files into Anki

After the purchase, you have received a .zip archive which looks like this:





Open it (if you can't open .zip files on your computer, [click here](#) to find out how you can do it). You will see folders with materials you bought:




Open the folder «**Anki Flashcards**». If you have successfully installed Anki (Step 1), you should be able to open the flashcards files in Anki:




If you still can't open them, launch Anki, create a new user and import the files through File > Import:




You can import files from the folder one by one:



After the import, you will see the deck in the list. Click on it to start studying:




Click on **Options** to personalize the way you want to study (number of cards per day / order of cards, etc.):



Step 3 — Create Anki account to synchronize and save your progress

Finally, to be able to use your cards on multiple devices and save your progress, you should create an Anki account.

To do this, click on **Sync** in the main Anki menu:



Follow the instructions in your browser.

After you create an account, you can sign in in your app and your progress will be always synchronized.
